

Things to consider bringing for overnight.

There is a guest book in the Cocoon the describes the site in detail.

Supplies – Food, Extra wood, Propane.

- If more than ten people stay, please bring extra blankets.
- Please bring extra water. There is a water dispenser in the office.
- Trancas Country Market Ten miles away.
30745 Pacific Coast Hwy, Malibu, CA 90265 – closed at 9:00pm
- Leo Carrillo State Park Campground Beach Store. Has most items.
5 miles away, closes at 8pm. Ask the ranger for directions at the gate.

Heating and Ventilation

The guest book in the Cocoon the describes this in detail.

- The Cocoon has a nest whole house ventilation.
- The large propane cauldron has use instruction in the guest book.
- If you are staying in the Cocoon, use the Hill-Top Spa.
The spas take about three hours to heat up. Start heating them mid-day
- Follow instructions for campfires in the guest book.
The spark screen must be used. Put the fire full out with hose when done.

Sleeping and Heating – power use.

- There are eight beds on the site. All come with an electric blanket.
- Please use the electric blankets and not the space heaters as the backup generator is being repaired.
- The main office may be used to sleep in. It has a couch and there are many bedrolls in the Cocoon closet.
- The site backup generator is being repaired on 10-15-2024
It is not recommended that space heaters be used for more than 1 hour as the off-grid System may go off at night with heavy use. Please turn off the spa unused appliances And unneeded light and you will not overload the system at night.
